

Pursuant to Article 28 paragraph 2 of the Law on control of manufacture and trade of substances that can be used in the manufacture of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances (Official Gazette of Montenegro 83/09), the Ministry of Health hereby issues the

Rulebook on the form and content of report on actual quantities of imported or exported precursors

The Rulebook was published in the Official Gazette of Montenegro 12/2015 of 16 March 2015, and entered into force on 24 March 2015

Article 1

This Rulebook shall lay down the form and content of report on actual quantities of imported or exported precursors.

Article 2

Report on actual quantities of exported precursors shall contain:

- 1) name and address of exporter (phone, fax, e-mail);
- 2) export authorization number;
- 3) trade name of preparation;
- 4) name of precursor in accordance with the regulation on the list of precursors;
- 5) tariff symbol (HS number);
- 6) CAS number;
- 7) anhydrous base content in percentages (%);
- 8) mode of packaging;
- 9) weight/volume of precursors in each unit (kg, l);
- 10) number of units;
- 11) actual quantity (weight/volume) of exported precursors (kg, l);
- 12) number and date of invoice;
- 13) name and address of importer and name of country importer;
- 14) number and date of import authorization issued by competent authority of country importer and the name of issuing authority;
- 15) name of manufacturer and name of country manufacturer;
- 16) name and address of end recipient;
- 17) mode of transport and information on means of transport;
- 18) name of exit customs office;
- 19) name of place of passing goods (merchandise customs office);
- 20) number and date of customs declaration;
- 21) date of entry;
- 22) other data relevant for the actual quantity of exported precursors;
- 23) place, date, stamp (L.S) and signature of authorized person.

Article 3

Report on actual quantities of imported precursors shall contain:

- 1) name and address of importer (phone, fax, e-mail);
- 2) import authorization number;
- 3) trade name of preparation;
- 4) name of precursor in accordance with the regulation on the list of precursors;
- 5) tariff symbol (HS number);
- 6) CAS number;
- 7) anhydrous base content in percentages (%);
- 8) mode of packaging;
- 9) weight/volume of precursors in each unit (kg, l);

- 10) number of units;
- 11) actual quantity (weight/volume) of imported precursors (kg, l);
- 12) number and date of invoice;
- 13) name and address of exporter and name of country exporter;
- 14) name of manufacturer and name of country manufacturer;
- 15) name and address of end recipient and the purpose of use of precursors;
- 16) mode of transport and information on means of transport;
- 17) name of entry customs office;
- 18) name of place of passing goods (merchandise customs office);
- 19) number and date of customs declaration;
- 20) date of entry;
- 21) other data relevant for the actual quantity of imported precursors;
- 22) place, date, stamp (L.S) and signature of authorized person.

Article 4

The reports on actual quantities imported or exported precursors shall be submitted in forms which make an integral part of this Rulebook (Annexes no. 1 and 2).

Article 5

This Rulebook shall enter into force on the eighth day following that of its publication in the Official Gazette of Montenegro.
